Subj: DEPENDENT TRAVEL IN GOVERNMENT VEHICLES


1. The following guidance is provided concerning dependent travel in government vehicles in conjunction with specific events, such as a training conference held in conjunction with the Marine Corps Ball.

2. Dependent travel in government vehicles is not permitted due to the following reasons:

a. The potential risk and liability to the Government in the event of an accident;

b. The availability of alternative modes of travel for such events. Recruiters may use their privately owned vehicles (POVs) and be reimbursed for mileage if appropriate; and,

c. The negative public perception of fraud, waste, abuse, and mismanagement of government resources.
