Subj: ACTIVATION AND MOBILIZATION IMPACT ON NON PRIOR  
SERVICE (NPS) RESERVES ENLISTED UNDER THE PROGRAM  
INCREMENTAL INITIAL ACTIVE DUTY FOR TRAINING (IIADT)

Ref: (a) MARADMIN 016/03 dated 14 Jan 03

1. Purpose. To notify all levels of the Marine Corps Recruiting Command, the procedures required for non-prior service reserve applicants enlisting for the incremental initial active duty for training (I/IADT) program.

2. Background. The reference provides policy on activation and mobilization of newly joined prior service and non-prior service Selected Marine Corps Reserve (SMCR) Marines. Specifically, the policy is I/IADT Marines assigned to units that are activated will return to their SMCR unit, be joined under the reporting unit code (RUC) for which they were recruited, and will be activated in order to conduct Marine Combat Training (MCT) and Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) training. These Marines will not be available for deployment outside the continental United States (OCONUS) until they complete MOS training and MCT.

3. Information. The I/IADT program is primarily designed to permit an individual to enlist in the Marine Corps reserve and complete recruit training during the break between high school graduation and the freshman year in college, and then return to a drilling reserve status with their parent SMCR unit. Subsequent breaks in school allow them to attend MCT and MOS training. As contained in the I/IADT Statement of Understanding (SOU), the exception to that policy is when reserves are activated or mobilized. MARADMIN 016/03, implements the activation or mobilization clause for I/IADT applicants and Marines. If the unit is activated or mobilized, applicants in the I/IADT program will not be released to attend college after completion of recruit training. They will be subsequently ordered to complete the remainder of their training in order to qualify for potential deployment. Since many applicants in the I/IADT program will be shipping to recruit training in late spring with expectations to start college in the fall, it is imperative that all applicants enlisted in this program are informed immediately of the activation and mobilization clause.

4. Action.

a. Effective immediately, inform all applicants enlisting in the I/IADT program and those currently awaiting IIADT of the following information:

(1) Depending on the current contingency requirements and duration of activations, applicants in the I/IADT program **who join a unit that has been activated** can expect to remain on active duty upon completion of recruit training and will not be able to attend college in the fall.

(2) Applicants in the I/IADT program **who join a SMCR unit, that has not been but later is activated**, will be required to withdraw from college in order to complete training.

b. Annotate on the DD 1966/4 Section VI Remarks, one of the following statements:

(1) Mobilized: " I understand the unit that I am being assigned is currently activated/ mobilized. Depending on the current contingency requirements and duration of activation, I can expect to remain on active duty upon completion of recruit training and will not be able to attend college."

(2) Not Mobilized: "I understand the unit that I am being assigned is currently not activated/ mobilized. Depending on current contingency requirements if that unit is activated or mobilized I will be required to withdraw from college in order to complete the remainder of my training."

c. When completing the SOU for the I/IADT program, ensure the applicant understands and acknowledges paragraph 12: "I realize that I will be liable for involuntary recall to active duty in case of national emergency proclaimed by the President of the United States and I may be required to serve not more than 24 months active duty. In time of national emergency or war declared by Congress, I may be required to serve for the duration of the national emergency or war and for 6 months thereafter. I may be required to serve at such times as the law may require."
