Subj: REALLOCATION OF ENLISTMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAMS AS A RESULT OF LOADING ERROR IN MCRISS-RS.

Encl: (1) Enlistment Incentive Program Allocations by Region.

1. Purpose. To notify Regions and Districts of modified allocations of Enlistment Incentive Programs (EIP), plan.
2. Background. Based on needs of the Marine Corps, Manpower Plans (MP) allocates enlistment incentive programs to this command. Current policy for Non Prior Service Regular (NPSREG) mission requires that 85% of new accessions be shipped with an EIP, while the remaining 15% are shipped as "open contracts". This allows MMEA-11 flexibility in assigning MOS and school seats through the Recruit Distribution Model (RDM). MCRC allocates these programs to Regions using a formula that factors expected pool losses into the equation.
3. Information. This command is correcting, by program, the errors in the requirements column that were loaded into the MCRISS-RS programs module at the beginning of FY02.
4. Action. MCRC Programs Section has adjusted the requirement and redistributed to each Region the modified enlistment incentives for the remainder of this FY. Each Region should coordinate District allocations directly with MCRC, G-3 by COB 11 Feb 02. Final adjustments to the Program Availability Module of MCRISS, reflecting the new allocations, will be made by COB 12 Feb 02. The enclosure is a by district template that reflects Regular Fair Share.
