1. Purpose. To notify all levels within the Marine Corps Recruiting Command of new implementation guidance for the DD 2807-2 Medical Prescreen of Medical History Report Form.

2. Background. On 2 Jan 01 the DD 2246 was replaced by the DD 2807-2. The DD 2807-2 requires parental signatures, as verification for all 17 year olds. This requirement raised concerns by MCRC that this procedure might not allow for honest and sincere information of pre-service drug history. The command requested that the preservice drug history be documented on the Drug Abuse Screening Form and attached to the DD 2807-2 when processing at the MEPS as outlined in reference (a). Reference (b) denied this request, and therefore reference (a) is hereby cancelled.

3. Information. The DD 2807-2 requires preservice drug history be documented in Block 2a.(73)a,b,and c. No other documents will be used or attached to the DD 2807-2.

4. Action. Effective **1 July 2001**, all applicants will be processed with the DD 2807-2. The preservice drug history will be documented in Block 2a.(73)a,b and c.. **THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS.** All 17 year old applicants require parental signature on the DD 2807.2, or processing will be denied.
