Subj: TERMINATING USE OF AUTOMATED RECRUIT MANAGEMENT
SYSTEM (ARMS) FOR ENLISTED RECRUITING

1. Purpose. To notify all levels within the Marine Corps Recruiting Command, the guidance in the terminating use of the Automated Recruit Management System (ARMS) for all enlisted recruiting.
2. Background. Marine Corps Recruiting Command (MCRC) has been entering data in ARMS and also using the new Marine Corps Recruiting Information Support System-RS (MCRISS-RS) over the last few months. Final testing and system upgrades to MCRISS-RS (MCRISS-RS Version 1.1.22) allow us to terminate use of ARMS for enlisted recruiting matters.
3. Information. The MCRISS-RS Web page lists Application Issues, Reports in MCRISS-RS, and Current Status of MCRISS-RS, and should be reviewed by all users.
4. Action. Discussions were held during the National Senior Commanders Conference on the termination date of ARMS, and the use of MCRISS-RS as the sole reporting system for enlisted recruiting. The effective date of **1 APRIL 2002** was established for the use of MCRISS-RS as the sole MCRC reporting system.
5. This frost call is not effective to ARMS OA, which will continue to be used for all Officer Selection Work.
